Training Supervisor Forum 24 July, 2009, Melbourne

GPET is convening a meeting of training supervisor stakeholders to develop shared policy positions on the support needs of general practice training supervisors. The goal of the forum is to identify the supervisor and supervisory resource requirements associated with the increased training levels anticipated over the coming years; and to develop a set of recommendations relating to those requirements to be presented to Government and associated reform bodies.

A steering committee has been established (including representatives from ACE, NGPSA, RACGP, ACRRM and GPSLOs) to oversee the development of the agenda, workshop themes and to identify key information inputs and pre-reading materials. Supervisors attending the Forum will be nominated by each RTP.
